Tarlac Electric Inc. (TEI) hereby reports on the filing of its application for the approval of Power Supply Agreement (PSA) with the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC) per RC Case No. 2026-048 RC¹, dated 08 April 2026, entitled "In the Matter of the Application for Approval of the Power Supply Agreement (PSA) Between Tarlac Electric Inc (TEI) and Sual Power Inc. (SPI) with Motion for Confidential Treatment of Information and Prayer for Provisional Authority and/or Interim Relief".

The PSA is for 10 MW, with escalation of up to 25 MW, baseload energy supply for a period of fifteen (15) contract years, or 180 billing months, commencing on 26 December 2026 or from the date of ERC's final approval, whichever comes later.

JOINT APPLICATION

APPLICANTS TEI and SPI, through their respective counsels, unto this Honorable Commission, respectfully alleges:

1. Applicant **TEI** is a Distribution Utility duly organized and existing under Philippine law with main office address at Mabini St., Brgy. Mabini, Tarlac City; franchised under R.A. No. 10795 to construct, operate and maintain an electric light, heat and power in Tarlac City; and is represented here by its President and General Manager, **VITUS M. ROMERO**.
2. Applicant **SPI** is an Independent Power Producer (IPP) duly organized and existing under Philippine law with main office address at 5th Floor, C5 Road, Bo. Ugong, Pasig City 1604; owner and operator of the **Sual Coal Fired Thermal Power Plant**, located at Brgy. Pangascasan Sual Pangasinan; and represented here by **ELENITA D. GO** and **PAUL BERNARD D. CAUSON**.

8. Thus, the Honorable Commission has recognized the importance of maintaining pricing structures as confidential in order to ensure the competitiveness of the generation sector. Information which falls within the definition of a trade secret as defined by jurisprudence, is information that merits the confidential treatment provided under Rule 4, Section 1 of the Revised ERC Rules. The Confidential Documents should therefore be entitled to the protection of confidential information provided under Rule 4 of the Revised ERC Rules.

9. Accordingly, one (1) copy of each of the foregoing confidential documents is placed in a sealed envelope, with the envelope and each page of the document stamped with the word "Confidential."

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, premises considered, the Applicants respectfully pray that the Honorable Commission:

- 1) GRANT a provisional authority and/or interim relief to implement the proposed Power Supply Agreement (Annex "01") upon filing of this joint application;
- 2) Upon due notice and hearing, approve the proposed Power Supply Agreement (Annex "01"); and
- 3) Treat the Applicants' Confidential Documents marked as **Annexes "23D" and "25 and series"** submitted in a sealed envelope and the information contained therein as confidential information and prescribe guidelines for the protection thereof.

Other reliefs, just and equitable in the premises, are likewise prayed for.
